ATG Group are committed to procuring ethical and sustainably-sourced materials, goods and services. We acknowledge that the choices we make when procuring these resources have a significant impact on people, organisations and the wider environment.

ATG Group are committed to the application of sustainable procurement practices throughout all aspects of the business.

In line with this Policy, ATG Group will endeavour to:

- Sources goods and services from companies that embody ATG's environmental, quality and H&S policies
- Ensure that fair contract prices and term are applied, and that our suppliers meet ethical, human rights and labour standards.
- Where possible, purchase local materials, products and services, supporting small businesses and minimising transportation distances.
- Reduce the purchase of new products by re-using or repairing existing products where possible.
- Promote the purchase of products that have minimal environmental impacts during their use e.g. durable, energy efficient, reusable or refillable.
- Use resources efficiently and consider end-of life uses
- Procure timber from legal and sustainable sources
- Procure durable goods and services, which reflect standards for environmental sustainability e.g. A- Rate certified.
- Procure recycled stationary including paper products where viable.
